DEAR DOG OWNER,

We are happy to inform you that your dog has been registered to the International Dog Show held on 11.-13.02.2011 in Tallinn, Saku Suurhall

The entrance will be opened 11.02 at 12:30, 12.02 and 13.02 at 8.30.

This Show is held under the Estonian Kennel Union Show Regulations (in effect since 15.02.2005). The Regulations are available at the Information Desk.

All dogs participating in the show or other competitions must have a valid certificate of vaccination according to the rules of Estonian Kennel Union (in effect since 1.08.2010). Please do not forget to take the vaccination certificate and pedigree with you.

Please bring your dog's registration certificate. In case the dog is registered for working or champion class, please bring the necessary documentation.

You will get your participation number at the information desk.

Please attach the participation number to your clothes where everyone can see it before entering the ring.

Only one person accompanying a dog is allowed free of charge to the show ground. Tickets: adults – 3 EUR, children (7-16) 1 EUR, students and seniors 1 EUR, family ticket 5 EUR, children under 7 – free of charge.

The show is a drive-in show. You can arrive at the show ground approximately 1 hour before your dog's breed judging start and leave immediately after the judging has been completed unless your dog has been entered to group competition.

With all questions regarding the show day please contact the info desk.

All complaints regarding the violation of formalities and existing rules must be submitted to the Organizing Committee in writing latest by the end of the day the given breed is judged together with the deposit (on this show 100 EUR). Only the owner and/or handler of the given dog may submit the complaint. More info + 372 51 75 958
